## Coronavirus Procedures

Due to the recent pandemic , The following precautions will go into effect, based on direction from CDC for group living facilities.

1. RESIDENTS will continue to go to day programs however, we will link our actions with theirs. Upon returning home their hands will be washed, and their chairs treated with sanitizer. Outings will be limited for the foreseeable future. Decisions about participation at day programs will be on a case by case basis.
2. STAFF are not to report to work if they have a cough and/or temperature. Staff will wash hands between interactions with residents and sanitize routinely. In addition staff will inform leadership of any resident health changes.
3. VENDORS will be asked to conduct business on the front porch.
4. FAMILIES will be asked not come in if they have a cold, cough, or temperature, even when they feel fine. Also if there has been travel outside the US we expect families to disclose that. For the family that takes their loved one home daily they will be asked to meet on the front porch. Virtual visits can be arranged thru house managers.
5. RESOURCES will be on automatic resupply and multiple trips will be made to ensure 2 weeks of supplies are always on hand. We do have emergency supplies packed up that can be used if needed, with the authorization of Rhonda Ferguson.
